In 2013, Reagan received a fellowship at the ADR Centre in Rome, Italy, for a study commissioned by the European Union regarding the Mediation Directive. She co-authored the study, which has been presented to the European Union and several European parliaments.

Since 2014, Reagan has judged written brief submissions for the Vis Arbitration Moot, in Vienna, Austria, and has assisted in advising Hamline's Vis International Arbitration Moot team. In 2016, Reagan achieved Member status with the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators, based in London, England.
